

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REAPPOINTMENT AND GRANTING
TENURE TO ELIZABETH PEDDICORD AS CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER FOR
THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSAUKEN

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-140.10 et seq., every municipality is required to appoint a Chief Financial Officer (CFO) to oversee the financial operations of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, on January 1, 2022, pursuant to Resolution 2022:05, the Township Committee consented to Elizabeth Peddicord as Chief Financial Officer for a four-year term; and

WHEREAS, Elizabeth Peddicord has completed her four-year term as Chief Financial Officer of the Township of Pennsauken and is eligible for reappointment with tenure pursuant to statute; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:9-140.8 provides that any person who serves as Chief Financial Officer for four consecutive years and is reappointed shall be granted tenure of office and cannot be removed except for good cause shown after a proper hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to reappoint Elizabeth Peddicord, CMFO, as Chief Financial Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 5th of March 2026, by the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsauken, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Township Committee does hereby grant its advice and consent to the reappointment of Elizabeth Peddicord, CMFO, as Chief Financial Officer of the Township of Pennsauken.
2. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-140.8, Elizabeth Peddicord is hereby granted tenure of office as Chief Financial Officer of the Township of Pennsauken.
3. The Municipal Clerk shall forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Division of Local Government Services in the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.
